- You can bring your palm branches to church and place them in the metal container near the baptismal font.
- The palm branches will be burned at our Fat Tuesday Pancake dinner on the evening of Tuesday, February 13.
- Ash Wednesday is on February 14. You will need to celebrate St. Valentine Day before Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence: no eating between meals and no meat. Mass times on Ash Wednesday are: 9:00 am and 7:00 pm in the Church and 2:00 pm in the Village.
- For Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, we will have faith sharing groups using Pope Francis' encyclical **Laudato Si'** as the basis for our learning, prayer and discussion. This encyclical is also known by its English title: "On Care for our Common Home". Sign-up sheets are available for the small Lenten groups. Everyone is encouraged to participate.
